

ST ANDREWS CATHEDRAL CRECHE



The Cathedral Crèche is available on a Sunday morning between 10.30am and 11.30am, for babies and preschool children while their parents attend the 10.45 Eucharist; the Crèche is held in the John Skinner Centre located behind the Cathedral. It is run by a group of volunteers from the congregation on a rota basis, all of whom are required to obtain a PVG (Protection of Vulnerable Groups) Disclosure Certificate for the safety of the children.

Parents have to sign a Permission Form with their names and contact numbers and each child's details e.g. name, age, special needs, allergies etc. We change nappies only with the parents' permission and will come and fetch you from church should the need arise.

During the Peace, parents return to the John Skinner Centre to pick up the children to join them for communion.

The crèche is a way of introducing the children gradually to our Eucharist service and we generally take the children in to Baptisms where we gather round the font to welcome new children to the Cathedral family. We also join the procession on Palm Sunday and take part in the Mothering Sunday Service, and Advent Candle Lighting Services to mention a few.

We provide various toys and activities for the children depending on their ages and we also play singing games and teach them songs to sing in church.

We are a happy group and we are always pleased to welcome new families.
